### 1. Matters arising from the record of the last meeting.

#### **Miners Monument**

Construction continues with approximately 50% completion of the monument. The bricklayer may be on site again soon, however the weather continues to be very wet which might slow progress.

There is £1976 left in the budget for this project. There are no concerns regarding keeping within budget.

WT and PWo are working on the "letter to the future" for the time capsule. James Parker provided material relating to mining in Essington which will be used to compile a potted history of mining for inclusion in the time capsule.
